➤ <i>Introductions</i>	Tami Eide, Pharm.D.	
➤ <i>Approval of Minutes from October 21, 2010</i>	Tami Eide, Pharm.D.	Minutes approved.
➤ <i>Question – Synagis</i>	Perry Brown, MD	Requested a review of the Synagis discussion from the October 21, 2010 meeting to further his understanding. The review clarified his questions.
➤ <i>Medical Claims</i>	Tami Eide, Pharm.D.	Dr. Eide reviewed the situation for retroDUR reviews at this time. Due to Magellan not receiving medical claims from the Molina MMIS system, it is difficult to do comprehensive DUR studies that require electronic diagnosis information. Also, the lack of medical claims causes the Auto PA system to not function properly and increases the PA staff workload.
➤ <i>Pharmacy Auto Refill practices.</i>	Tami Eide, Pharm.D	Dr. Eide reviewed recent information from patients, staff and community sources that many pharmacy chains and some independent pharmacies are automatically filling routine medications every 30 days, including certain PRN medications – such as rescue inhalers. Dr. Brown noted that this information confirmed why he is receiving calls that are not generated by the patient. An active conversation ensued about this potential system overuse. We will continue to review through various resources and other states.
