COVID-19 Vaccine Information

Idaho Department of Health and Welfare will be reimbursing Pharmacies at Pharmacy Point of Sale according to the dose being administered. There will not be any ingredient costs associated with these vaccines at this time.

The quantity dispensed for each individual patient vaccine should be treated as a “milliliter”. The billing unit will be a milliliter (ML) for the individual vaccine with the quantity of the number of units dispensed depending on the manufacturer (e.g., 0.3 mL per individual vaccination) and the proper days supply a value of “1”.

Pharmacies must submit a Submission Clarification Code = 2 (NCPDP Field # 420-DK) to be reimbursed a dispense fee of \$15.25 (State Rule allows for 90% of Medicare Reimbursement Fees) for the initial dose and a Submission Clarification Code = 6 (NCPDP Field # 420-DK) to be reimbursed a dispense fee of \$25.55 (State Rule allows for 90% of Medicare Reimbursement Fees) for the final dose of a series for two-dose vaccines. Pharmacies that leave blank or submit anything other than a 2 or 6 in the SCC Field will be reimbursed their normal tiered dispensing fees for these products.
